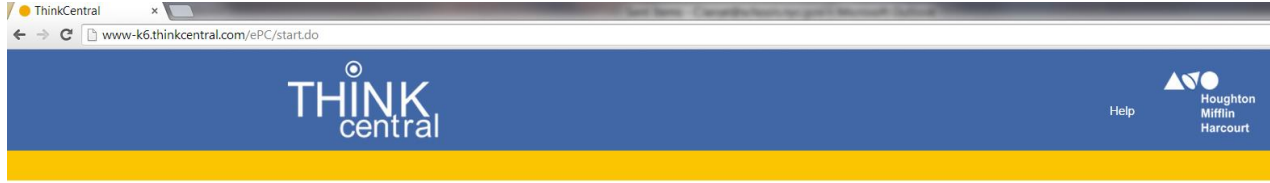


How to Log onto GOMath! (<http://www-k6.thinkcentral.com>)

Choose "Ps 196 Grand Central Parkway..." It's about 2/3 of the way down the list
