First grade kicked off 2016 by beginning our Reading Unit on Becoming a Classroom Citizen. We are working on understanding the details in texts to help us retell stories and identify the central message.

As young writers, we will formulate an opinion and supply evidence to support reasons for the opinion. As Learners, we will explore content to understand how children contribute to a classroom community as “classroom citizens.”

In Science our students are learning about the states of matter – solids, liquids and gases.

In Social Studies we are learning about different types of communities and the people and places that make up the different communities. We are also discussing the different holidays that we celebrate in February.
